## Cement Skull Planter

## Supplies:

- Cement \*\* (Use fast setting hydraulic cement to complete project within a few hours or concrete mix to complete project within a few days)
- 2 large buckets (five quarts or larger) \*\*
- 1 small container (one quart) \*\*
- Paint mixing stick \*\*
- Tin snips \*\*
- Cleaning gloves \*\*
- Plastic skull shaped container (or plastic pumpkin shaped pail)
- Flowers (real or artificial)
- Cooking spray

\*\* = available at Evey True Value Hardware while supplies last

## Instructions:

- 1. Spray the *inside* of the skull shaped container with cooking spray. This will allow for easier extraction once the cement is hardened.
- 2. Spray the *outside* of the small container with cooking spray as well.
- 3. Before mixing the cement, fill one of the large buckets with cold water. The other large bucket will remain empty as it will be used for mixing.
- 4. When ready, pour the dry cement powder into the large empty bucket.
- 5. Then, pour in the water and mix them together until it reaches a liquid consistency.
- 6. Quickly pour the liquid cement mixture into the skull shaped container to fill it about 75% of the way.
- 7. Then, quickly push the small container into the center of that cement mixture and hold there until the cement hardens around it.
- 8. When the cement in the skull shaped container is hard and a light gray color, it is ready for extraction.
- 9. Pull the small container out of the hardened cement skull.
- 10. Use the tin snips to cut the plastic skull shaped container completely off of the hardened cement skull.
- 11. Fill the finished cement skull planter with beautiful flowers!
